

RISING SENIORS...You have the chance to paint your very own RESERVED PARKING SPOT for the 2023-2024 school year!

How to Register

If you are a class of 2024 school year student and wish to obtain a reserved painted parking spot, you must complete the following steps to be considered for approval:

- Download the Painted Parking Spot Packet from <u>www.pacehighschoolptso.com</u> or pick-up from the PHS Front Desk beginning Monday, April 17, 2023 or at scheduled in-person pick-up days.
- □ Pay an **ONLINE ONLY** registration fee of \$100 plus S2 processing fee.
 - Registration will be done <u>exclusively</u> through the S2 App from May 1 May 5, 2023 only.
 - This registration includes a reserved parking decal, a choice of parking spot among the available reserved spots (first come first serve), and permission to paint your parking spot (once the design is approved). Proceeds from the \$100.00 registration fee will be invested by PTSO in projects directly benefiting the school, as well as portions to the PHS Athletics Department and the Senior Class.
- Completion and submission of 1) Painted Parking Spot Agreement, 2) Senior Painted Parking Design Request, and 3) PHS Parking Permit Application, to the PHS Front Office for PTSO and administrative approval by May 5, 2023. You will be notified of your approval via email.

Parking Space Assignment

Students are highly encouraged to purchase online as soon as the sale becomes active in the S2 if there is a desire to obtain a specific reserved spot. S2 will have an interactive map where students will be able to select their spot and checkout within 10 minutes. If the check-out process is not completed in that timeframe, the spot will be released for selection by another purchaser.

No review will be done until all forms are completed. Failure to submit all paperwork by the deadline will result in a release of a reserved parking spot, and a partial refund of the registration fee. This will be the only opportunity to reserve a painted parking spot for the 2023-2024 school year.

Painting Dates and Times

Eligible students will be painting their parking spots only on the dates below:

Painting Dates and Times Continued...

* Spots that have not begun to be painted by the end of this day will not be able to begin. Spots must be completed, and any sealant applied (optional) by the end time on Sunday, August 6. No exceptions. Students MAY NOT paint during periods outside of those above or may be subject to disciplinary action, including forfeiture of spot.

Painted Parking Spot Rules

- You MUST purchase/provide your own paint and brushes to use to decorate your parking spot. WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT is the <u>only type</u> of paint that can be used. No spray, reflective, fluorescent, interior or craft paint is permitted. (Consider sharing with others)
- Students MUST provide a drop cloth to set the paint and associated supplies on near their spot, along with a trash bag to discard all unused materials. NO PAINT OR TRASH OF ANY KIND MAY BE DISPOSED OF ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. STUDENTS ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAINT DISPOSAL OFF-CAMPUS.
- 3. Students are responsible for paint containment and must clean and/or cover all spills.
- Students are responsible for cleaning their spot and painting over any previous design on the spot selected. NO REPAIRS WILL BE MADE TO SPOTS; PLEASE INSPECT YOUR DESIRED SPOTS PRIOR TO PURCHASE TO VIEW THEIR CONDITION.
- 5. The assigned Reserved Parking Decal must be visible on the vehicle associated with the spot.
- 6. Students must not paint over the parking spot number, nor paint on the parking spot lines, and the design must be school appropriate and follow the below guidelines.
- 7. All designs must be pre-approved. The painted Parking Spot Packet (which includes all required forms and design) is due no later than Friday, May 5, 2023, prior to the final bell. A copy of the design for your parking spot may be drawn in planned colors on the attached form, or the student may attach a graphic representation (photo or rendering of the proposed design). Your design sheet will not be returned, so please make a copy for yourself prior to submission. Designs must be approved by PTSO and PHS administration. Once reviewed, you will receive an email letting you know if your design has been accepted or if any changes need to be made.
- 8. HAVE FUN!!! Allowing students to paint their parking spots improves school pride and camaraderie among peers. Students can create their own unique piece of the school in their final year. We encourage students to express themselves through POSITIVE artwork.
- You must follow the approved design as approved on painting day NO CHANGES ALLOWED WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION.
- 10. Students are encouraged to be original. If duplicate designs are submitted, both students will be notified and provided an opportunity to alter their design for review and approval.

Prohibited Themes/Content

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Disciplinary and Criminal actions may be taken. If this happens, you will not only be forfeiting your right to a parking spot and/or to drive on campus but you will also forfeit any monies collected. Parking lots are under surveillance.

- No political or potentially divisive content/imagery
- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols
- No negative or rude language (BE NICE)
- No double-entendres (double meanings)
- No artist/celebrity/professional athlete names; sports team names/logos may be used.
- You may use YOUR name. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved (a boyfriend's or girlfriend's name is NOT allowed)



Painting Day

Before you begin painting, check in at the PHS PTSO table located in the Main Lot to pick up decals. Students are recommended to bring a PRINTED copy of their design; a reminder that students MUST follow the design as approved.

We are very excited to offer students and parents an affordable and efficient way to purchase paint, and associated supplies. Pace parent Ricky Haugen, with PPG paints, has put together a great assortment of items that may be needed to paint your parking spot.

An electronic order form (pre-payment required) will be available once the initial parking spot sales have closed to order anything you may need. Students can choose from ANY Glidden or PPG paint color (swatches available at Home Depot or Walmart). Discounts will only apply through this online pre-purchase program, which will be available until early July. Pricing includes tax and delivery will be made to the school with several designated pick up days.

Rules and Regulations for Parking at Pace High School

Parking spaces on campus for 2023/2024 are limited. <u>I understand that being permitted to park on Pace High School's campus</u> is a privilege, and failure to obey any rules may result in school discipline, fines, booting, towing, and/or loss of this privilege. <u>Guidelines will be strictly enforced</u>.

- 1. All students who drive a vehicle on Pace High School's campus must have a parking decal/permit.
- 2. Student parking decals may be purchased from Student Services for \$20. Reserved parking permits may be purchased for \$50 from the Athletics office (via S2 or in the office).
- 3. DECALS/PERMITS MUST BE PERMANENTLY PLACED ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE REAR (BACK) WINDOW IN THE TOP LEFT CORNER.
- 4. Students may park in designated student parking areas only, which are the white lined spaces, or if you have purchased reserved parking which is yellow number spaces.
- 5. To effectively and quickly monitor the parking lot for safety reasons, vehicles must pull forward into a parking spot.
 - 1st offense \$20 fine (Cash or check only no coins.)
 - **2nd offense** \$20 fine and driving privileges revoked for four (4) weeks.
 - **3**rd offense \$20 fine and driving privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the year.
- 6. <u>Parking on the grass is not allowed except behind the football field visitor side.</u>
- 7. The speed limit is **5 MPH** in the parking lot and any other campus area.
- 8. Safety risks, such as careless driving, speeding, excessive noise, or other traffic violations will not be tolerated.
- 9. A parking permit is registered to **ONE STUDENT** and **ONE STUDENT ONLY** and is not transferable.
- 10. Students may not return to their cars/parking lot during the school day for any reason without permission from Student Services. A safety vest will be issued if permission is granted and should then be returned to Student Services.
- 11. All vehicles on the PHS campus are subject to search. The student driver is responsible for all items in the vehicle, including any drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vaping products/tools, weapons, and any other items prohibited by the Santa Rosa Code of Student Conduct.
- 12. Profane, obscene, abusive language or gestures, or other questionable symbols/language as outlined by the SRC Code of Student Conduct will not be permitted on vehicles that are parked on the PHS campus.
- 13. If a citation is issued, the student has <u>five (5) days</u> to pay the fine or appeal the citation to Assistant Principal, Mrs. Filbert. <u>After 5 days, the appeal is forfeited, and the fine is doubled.</u>
- 14. If you drive a different vehicle to school (other than the one registered), you must notify Student Services of your name and the tag # of the vehicle you are driving.
- 15. Any student with truancy concerns (chronic absences or late to-school check-ins/outs) may lose the privilege of parking on campus. This will be decided by the Pace High School Administration Team. Bus transportation is available for students.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- **PHS citations are \$20**. Failure to pay the fine within five (5) days from the date issued will result in the fine doubling to \$40. Unpaid fines result in loss of parking privilege.
- Parking/traffic citations must be paid by cash or check (no coins) in Student Services.
